Established in 1927, South Suburban College is a fully accredited, comprehensive community college with an annual student population of approximately 15,000. Located in South Holland, Illinois, SSC offers over 40 unique career education programs awarding transferable college credit, certificates, and Associate degrees. What financial assistance is available?

Do I need to take a Placement Test?

New full-time college students should register for a Placement Test unless this requirement is waived by a counselor. The Placement Test is a series of tests developed by American College Testing that identifies the strengths, knowledge and skills you need in order to succeed in specific areas.

The *University and College Center* is SSC's Oak Forest extension site. It offers daytime and evening credit courses, computer labs, an electronic library, distance learning and registration services. The *UCC* follows the same registration schedule as the Main Campus.
